The White Rose Novice Diving Invitational
14th & 15th October 2017

In conjunction with Leeds City Council the City of Leeds Diving Club is proud to invite you to the 2017 White Rose Novice Diving Invitational.

The competition will be held at the John Charles Centre for Sport, Aquatics Centre in South Leeds. The pool is a state of the art facility boasting a full complement of springboards and platforms with a fully equipped dryland training area.

The divers will perform 12 skills. These skills will be divided into 3 stations of 4 skills and assessed with 3 judges at each. The competitors will be divided across the 3 stations and rotated once each station has finished. Once the final result has been calculated the top 6 divers will progress to the final where 3 designated skills will be repeated.

Awards will be given to the top 6 finalists, Top Coach and the Top Team will receive the White Rose trophy.

On behalf of the organising team, the City of Leeds Diving Club and Leeds City Council, we look forward to welcoming you to what will be one of the most exciting novice competitions this year!!!

EVENT CONDITIONS (Separate events for boys and girls)

If a Diver has dived in any Age Group or Elite event they are not eligible to dive at White Rose – this NOVICE event is aimed at divers starting out along their diving career. All divers must be Swim England Cat 2 Registration.

4. Reverse Pike Sit w/a	4. x1 Dive from List B*	4. Back Tuck Roll from Crouch (1.3)

**NOTE: Forward and Reverse Dives (this does not include x1-2 bounce 100b on 1m) may be performed Standing with T armswing, X2 Bounce or Hurdle*

3m Fwd Line Ups: Pike Fall Hands Grabbed (1.0) Sitting Tuck to Pike Roll (1.2)

3m Back Line Ups: Standing Back Fall Straight – hands on thighs (1.4) Crouch Back Tuck Roll (1.3)

**NOTE: Forward and Reverse Dives may be performed Standing with T armswing or Hurdle*

Top 6 Divers will advance to the final and perform the following skills (no carry over score):-

JUDGING

In order to satisfy the judging requirements for this type of event we will supply a judge for each panel at each station in the preliminary. The rest of the panels will be made up from the attending clubs. There will be 3 judges per station. We will nominate a referee for each panel.

In the Finals there will be a panel of 5 Judges – one from Leeds and the rest from the attending clubs.

Judges lists will be posted in advance.

Dive Sheets must be submitted on line electronically prior to your arrival.

Close of play for electronic dive sheets is: Thursday 12th October

Divers/Coaches are requested to submit dive sheets electronically, both for their own convenience and to minimize the chance of errors loading the data into the Recording program. Coaches may make bulk submission of dive sheets on behalf of their divers by using the program DiveSheets with which they will already be familiar. Alternatively, individual divers may submit their own dive sheets on-line. Please agree with your coach which method you should use.

To submit your dive sheets on-line there are two options:

- Either visit: www.diverecorder.co.uk/onlinesheets and follow the instructions, or
- if you have an Android phone or tablet, you can get the **ADiveSheets app** from this page on the DiveRecorder website: www.diverecorder.co.uk/dive/android

As soon as you complete either on-line submission method you will see a success/failure message. If successful you will be sent an automatic email confirming receipt of your details and dives.

You can check your submitted dive sheets a few days before the event online at www.diverecorder.co.uk/live. If you experience problems and need assistance please contact Ann Barker (AnnBarker@aol.com).

We will allow changes to dive sheets up to one hour before the start of the each day's events.
